Dear Friends of Second Church,

This coming Sunday at our 10:30 Worship Service, we will be delighted to welcome Katie Nelson as our musical guest.

A recognized composer, arranger, and performer of Christian music, she is based in Greenwich and serves as an active worship leader at several area churches, and is particularly known for her emotionally rich, evocative singing of both new and skillfully reimagined traditional hymns.

Katie is also the musical director for our weekly Evensong worship service on Saturday nights at 5 p.m. in the Chapel.

If you haven't had the chance to go yet, you're missing out.

Between Katie's music and Shawn's preaching, Evensong is offering something deeply faithful, but unique here at 2CC—an expression of worship that it may be most accurate to say that you *feel* even more than you see or hear it. It's the kind of service that leaves many people almost stunned for a moment at the end, or inclined to say that they didn't know worship could be *like that*.

Even as someone who knows and loves traditional worship most of all, I have gotten a great deal from Evensong, and have often found it a welcome pause in my own weekend as I prepare for Sunday—a time when I can truly feel God's presence for myself, and hear God's voice in new ways.

With that in mind, the Church Council, Shawn and I want to offer you a small taste of what's been happening on Saturday nights here this year. Within the familiar structure of our 10:30 Worship Service this Sunday, Shawn and Katie will include some of the elements of the Evensong service, particularly in the service music we will offer, but with other subtle touches, as well.

I encourage you to come, and to receive it as the gift it is. We're sure you'll be blessed by it.


