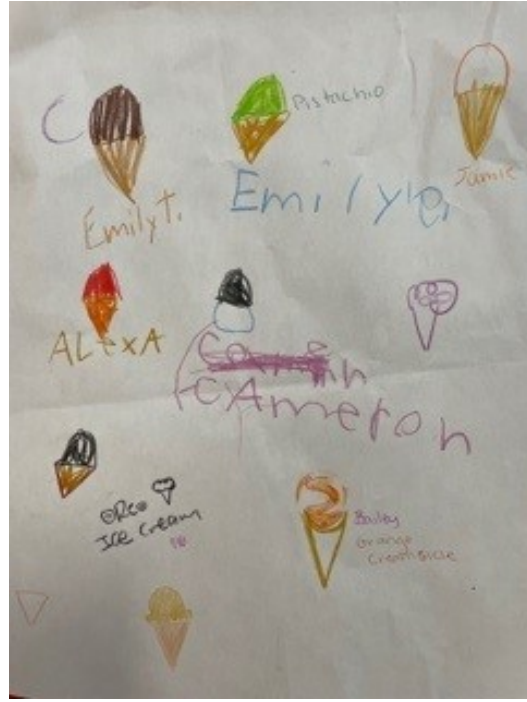
Sunday, July 10 in Children's Chapel: I scream you scream, we all scream for Sundaes....

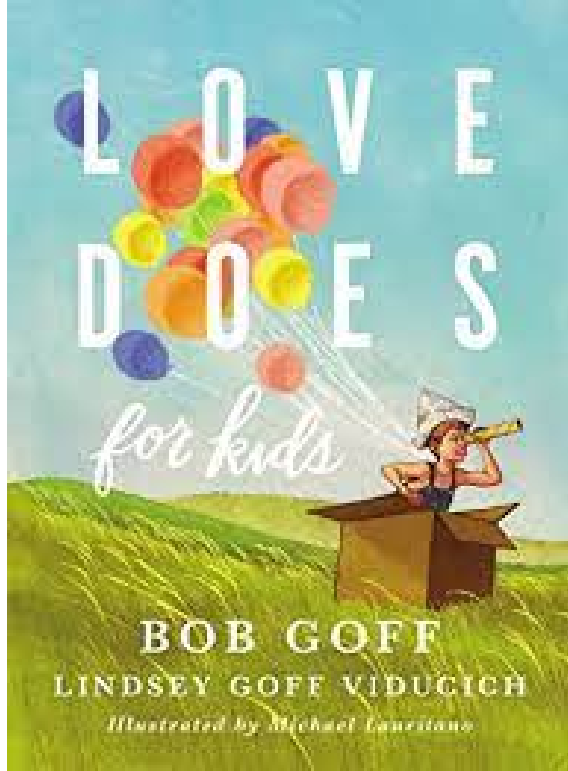

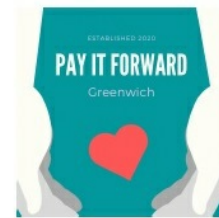
