Also on Friday at 4 p.m., here at 2CC, we will celebrate the life of Daryn Lee, a longtime member of our church, daughter of Ilda and Chuck Lee, and beloved aunt and sister for the Fichtner, Evans, Lee and Smith families.

On Saturday at 11 a.m., we will hold services for Ernest Pelletier, the father of Dan Pelletier, and grandfather of Danielle, Arya, and Kalyan Pelletier.

Your presence is certainly welcome.

But I think our community is at its finest in the weeks that follow a service, when our friends are first learning to "live into" a life that has suddenly become very different than it used to be, and the steadying rituals of initial grief are over, whether they were planning a funeral, beginning the probate process, working through all the food that's been dropped off, writing all those thank you notes.

At a certain point, people stop remembering to ask how a newly grieving person is doing.

That's when the power of spiritual friendships becomes so important—being close enough to know when to ask and when not to, and to know the right way to stay close without becoming another problem for someone to manage among all the others.

At a time when so much feels just so hard, that kind of support and care can be something that's just right.

Bless it for that.


