June 1, 1941 - March 13, 2023

Jane M. Corcoran, a long-time resident of Greenwich, CT passed away on Monday, March 13, 2023, after a lengthy illness. She was 81 years old. The family is deeply saddened by her loss.

Jane was born in Bridgeport, CT to the late James Corcoran and Marjorie Smith Corcoran. Raised in Bridgeport, CT and Westwood, MA, Jane was a graduate of Westwood High School and Middlebury College in VT, receiving a bachelor's degree in math in 1963. She began a career in computer technology at Bell Labs before marrying and raising her family in Connecticut. From 1980-1984 the family lived in Brussels, Belgium before returning to reside in Greenwich. Jane returned to her career after raising her daughters and worked at IBM until her retirement in 2003.

Jane was known for her quick wit and dry sense of humor. She enjoyed travel, reading, golf, music, and cooking. She loved spending summers at her beautiful lake home in New Hampshire. She was an avid gardener and was always happy surrounded by her many plants. Jane was a long-time member of the Second Congregational Church in Greenwich, CT and spent many years volunteering as a co-chairperson in their Act II consignment shop. She was involved in the Pi Beta Phi Alumni Club, 2CC Women's Fellowship and Women's Club of Greenwich, among others.

Jane is survived by her daughters, Kathryn Micati of Greenwich, CT and Heather Micati of New York, NY; her brother, William Corcoran and his wife, Kathleen; her two nephews, James Corcoran, and Andrew Corcoran; and ex-husband, Victor Micati.

Holy Week Prayer Vigil

Following the Maundy Thursday evening service, our overnight prayer vigil will begin, and will continue until 3:00 p.m. on Friday, April 7.

A feature of Holy Week at 2CC for the last 21 years, the vigil offers a powerful experience for private prayer in the Sanctuary, which is illuminated by a single light, focused from the base of the cross. Some come with a plan for their prayers, some read Scripture or find other devotional reading and go where it takes them, and some simply sit and "listen for God" in the silence. Most find that the hour passes quickly, and that Easter is more powerful as a result. Join us!
