I'm trying.

Sometimes we are reminded what a blessing it is just to be able to practice such attention, and how much work it can be to try resting, at least at first.

As we move into August, I hope you are making some progress, too.

***Community, encouragement, spiritual refreshment & support.***

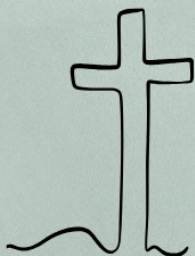
