Dear Friends of Second Church,

Now that we have returned to the rhythm of weekly services at 8:30 and 10:30, held in the Chapel and the Sanctuary, respectively, we'd like to invite all singers and joyful noise-makers to join our adult choir, which performs monthly during our 10:30 Worship Service.

The repertoire is meaningful and fun without being too "technical," and there's plenty of work you can do on your own to learn your part, in addition to Sunday group practices after church. If you've ever considered "robing up" and being part of this life-giving ministry, this offers a great way to get started or to get back into it.

Now, I should admit that, while Alexander and I are dear friends and close colleagues, we see church music largely as Senior Ministers and Music Directors have ever since King David first picked up his harp: I see *music as a way to create community*, and he sees *community as a way to create music*. (Ok, that's maybe just a *little* unfair, but you get my meaning.)

Where we would very much agree is that music and community go closely together. Along those lines, the wonderful folk singer Pete Seeger once wrote that, "A 'singing' movement is a winning movement," for such is the power of music to create a sense of shared purpose and joy.

We see it every year at 2CC, when we conclude our Easter service with a come-up-and-sing-if-you-want-to version of Handel's "Hallelujah Chorus." But in truth, there are many more moments like that throughout the church year, each one of them holy and life-giving to our people.

Nursery care for infants to age 4 starts at 10:15 a.m. Deacons can help direct you to our nursery room.


